

Visiting /Non-Degree Seeking Student Application Requirements

- 1) Completed Visiting Student Application
- 2) Statement of Interest
- 3) Resume/CV
- 4) Official Transcript or in lieu of transcripts, the applicant may submit a letter from the undergraduate/graduate school dean/registrar at the applicant's home institution confirming that the applicant is in good academic standing.

NOTE: Letters of Recommendation and GRE/GMAT test scores are not required.

Additional Registration Information for Visiting/Non-Degree Seeking Students:

Eligible applicants: Incoming college juniors and seniors; currently enrolled graduate students, and early-/mid-career individuals with a college degree.

Undergraduates enrolled at other institutions should, for their own benefit, obtain approval from their dean to ensure that courses taken at Pepperdine will fit into their program and that the credits will be transferable.

While the School of Public Policy is happy to consider scholarship requests for our non-degree students (see application for additional scholarship consideration requirements), Pepperdine University does not process financial aid for non-degree seeking or visiting students.
