How To Read Your Account Summary

When there is a balance on the account, this box will appear.

What each category dollar amount includes:

- You Owe (See Example 1)
 - o This is a total of ALL charges that have not yet been paid.
 - This amount includes charges that are due now (includes past due and due in the future).
- Due Now (See Example 2)
 - This is the total of all charges due within the next 14 days, including any past due balances.
- Future Due (See Example 2)
 - This is the total of all charges with a due date of more that 14 days from the current date.
- **You have a past due balance of 000.00.** (See Example 2)
 - o If there is a past due amount on the account, this line will appear in the box to show the exact amount of the Due Now total that is past due.

Example 1



This account is current and does not owe anything in the next 13 days. However, there are charges of \$18,925.00 on the account that will be due 14 or more days in the future.

Example 2



This account has an amount past due of \$572.80 and an amount due within 14 days of \$0.15. Therefore, the Due Now amount totals \$572.95 (\$572.80 + \$0.15). There are also charges on the account of \$4,790.00 that will be due 14 or more days in the future.
